Here is a list of some common regular English verbs. Add “s” to third person (he, she, it) to form the “present”. If the verb ends in “e”, add only “s”.

Add “ed” to form the simple past and past participle for all persons. ”. If the verb ends in “e”, add only “d”.

Example:

Accept I accept my responsibility. (present) I accepted the gift. (past)
